
The Coshocton Community Development Fund was created as an opportunity for individuals, corporations, foundations, and others who wish to contribute to make a difference in our economy!

- Funds are invested by the Coshocton Foundation and managed with the help of the Coshocton Port Authority.
- Contributions may be tax deductible and are intended to support needed economic development efforts of the community.
- The funds will make a positive change in your community and allows you or your organization to make a difference.
- Funds also provide financial support for entrepreneurs and small businesses and/or offer matching funds of state/federal funds that lead to job creation.

Application Review

Each use of the funds shall be approved by the Coshocton Port Authority board of Directors. Each application for the financial assistance and/or use of the funds shall be reviewed by the Coshocton Port Authority Executive Director to determine eligibility and effectiveness. Requests for business financing may require a review by the Small Business Development Center in New Philadelphia.

Annual Progress Report

The Coshocton Port Authority shall hold an annual progress report meeting every fall to present members with a detailed report of the fund's management/performance and community impact.

Payment Options

The timing and payment of contributions by businesses, organizations, and individuals will be determined on a case to case basis.

- Provide relocation assistance grants of up to \$25,000 for Coshocton County high school graduates who return and create a new business.
- Used to fulfill local match requirements for economic development activities supported by the state or federal government.
