Other Domestic

B. Motion for Contempt- Juvenile Court

This form can be used to file a motion with the Juvenile Court requesting that a party previously named in a case be held in contempt for disobeying a court order.

Custody

C. Custodial Parent Relocation

Use this packet to give notice of an intent to relocate by a custodial parent to a non-custodial parent. Use in Common Pleas or Juvenile whenever there is a custody order.

D. Agreed Petition for Custody- Juvenile Court

Use when parents have never been married or when parents are married but have never filed for divorce, dissolution, or legal separation in the Common Pleas Court. Use when parents agree as to who shall be the custodial parent and there is no prior court order.

E. Agreed Petition for Custody- Three Parties Involved- Juvenile Court

Use when parents have never been married or when parents are married but have never filed for divorce, dissolution, or legal separation in the Common Pleas Court. Use when parents are agreeing to give custody to a third party (e.g., grandparent).

F. Complaint for Custody- No Agreement- Juvenile Court

This packet is to be used when the parents have never been married or when the parents are married but have never filed for divorce, dissolution, or legal separation in the Common Pleas Court and there is no agreement regarding custody. If the Petitioner is not a parent, this packet can be used, but it may be confusing.

G. Agreed Motion for Change of Custody- Juvenile Court

Use when parents have never been married or when parents are married but have never filed for divorce, dissolution, or legal separation in the Common Pleas Court. Use when parents agree to jointly change custody and there is a prior court order designating custody.

H. Motion for Change of Custody- No Agreement- Juvenile Court

Use when parents have never been married or when parents are married but have never filed for divorce, dissolution, or legal separation in the Common Pleas Court. Use when one parent disagrees with the current custody arrangement and wants to get it changed and the other parent does not agree.

Visitation

M. Petition to Establish Visitation- Parents Never Married- Juvenile Court

This packet can be used by parents and non-parents to establish visitation when the parents were never married and paternity has been established.

O. Motion to Modify Visitation- Juvenile Court

This packet can be used by parents or non-parents to modify current visitation orders through the Juvenile Court.
