Specifications for Supplying Fuel to the Coshocton County Engineer's Office

GENERAL CONDITIONS

The Coshocton County Commissioners are requesting bids for gasoline, low sulfur diesel, high sulfur diesel, and kerosene for use by the County Engineer's Department. The various fuels will be obtained from the bidder's place of business if it is within 1 road mile of the county garage facility. If not located within this distance, the bid shall include the placement of an above ground storage tank, complete with electric dispensing pumps and metering, for the low sulfur diesel fuel, on the county garage premises. The AST shall meet all applicable codes and will remain the property of the bidder.

The bidder must be able to supply fuel 24 hours per day, 7 days per week at their place of business.

The bidder shall provide that all purchases made at the bidder's place of business be identified with the following information:

- Date of Purchase;
- County Vehicle Identification Number;
- Number of gallons of what product purchased;
- Signature of employee making the purchase;
- Copy of the "ticket" shall be provided to the employee at the time of purchase.

The bidder shall quote the price per gallon to be charged over the current rack price. The rack price shall include all applicable taxes. Written documentation of the current rack price shall be provided to the County by the bidder upon the County's request.

FEDERAL TAX EXEMPTION

Section 6416 of the Internal Revenue Service Code permits a local government to purchase fuel free from federal tax if the local government agrees not to claim the refund. Instead, the supplier pays the tax and claims the refund. This option is voluntary on the part of the supplier.

BID PRICE

The County Engineer's Office used approximately **10,000** gallons of high sulfur diesel, **32,000** gallons of low sulfur diesel, and **4,700** gallons of gasoline in 2010.
