Discussion - Mike LaVigne

Mr. Mike LaVigne attended the meeting to update the Commissioners on his attendance at a Broadband Meeting he recently attended. He stated that nothing was really any different than at previous meetings he attended. He explained that the county would like to utilize the Marx Towers but is unwilling to pay the \$1.00 per foot for the use. He stated that they intend to take this information to the governor to see if he will be able to help the county with this. He then stated that Marietta is doing similar things to get broadband to the out lying areas in their county. He also stated that there was a lot of discussion about the low interest loans to help with these projects. He really feels that if we can get the Marx Towers on board, Coshocton County will be way ahead of every other rural county. Mr. Fischer stated that the Commissioners will continue to work on this project. They have sent a letter to governor requesting his help on the Marx Towers. They will continue to work on this project because the Commissioners feel it is a very important issue for the county.

Discussion - Water Wells

Mr. Matt Robinette attended the meeting and stated that Keen Drilling will be here on Friday to test the well on the property at Airport Road. Mr. Fischer stated that he feels that since we will not be able to utilize the existing well that is there, we should find our 300 foot radios and do a test well there. Mr. Shryock is worried that we will not get an acceptable amount of water in that spot. Mr. Robinette stated that he feels we should test the existing well and determine if it in fact it can produce the amount of water needed for a water plant. Mr. Shryock stated that he agrees with Mr. Fischer that we need to determine if we can get two wells in that area and if they will pump sufficient water. He will need to determine the 300 foot isolation and get an estimate from Keen to determine what can be done. Mr. Robinette stated that he will let the Commissioners know what he finds out.
