If a new survey is needed, the Commissioner's suggested using Hitchen's & Associates if they want the work and if it can be done in a timely manner.

The survey from the water tower at the Airport has been done. Matt will give Craig Casey a copy.

Matt brought up another issue concerning Mike Boals. Mike wants a surface application for water. The issue that Fred Wachtel has is the water tap has been there but nothing has been paid on the water bill toward debt reduction. Mike hasn't used any water but wants to use it again. Mr. Shryock asked about the flat tap fee of \$20 and where it stands. After discussion, Mr. Stahl made a motion to go with the flat fee of \$20.00 with Mr. Fischer, seconding it. Motion passed.


Stephen Cox – Assistant Dog Warden

Mr. Shryock brought Mr. Stahl up to date concerning the assistant dog warden. Steve Cox started last Monday. His office is upstairs in the Annex Building. Steve will be using a Sheriff's cruiser that has been sitting at the Maintenance Garage. Steve wants to know if the car can be taken home at night. He has a big garage that the car can be put in. Mr. Shryock said there might be something said with the car sitting a lot in one place since Steve only works 20 hours a week. There were no objections to this being done.


Steve also wants to put pet carriers in the back seat of the car. Mr. Fischer has one that he will donate for this purpose.

At 11:01 AM Mr. Shryock adjourned the meeting.




