Michelle Darner- Investment Report

Ms. Darner attended the meeting to present the Commissioners with an update on the County's investments.

Jeff Wherely-Litter Report

Mr. Jeff Wherely attended the meeting to give a litter update. Computer collection was held on November 10th and 90 people drop up computers which was enough to fill a semi truck which qualified for a free shipping. Rob Daugherty will be doing the refurbishing of the recycle trailers and he hopes to get that done before the end of the year

Mr. Terry Miller-JFS

Mr. Terry Miller attended the meeting to discuss heating/cooling issues at the JFS building. They currently use Standard heating and cooling, Canton, Ohio. Mr. Miller would like to switch to a Johnson Plumbing and Heating, Coshocton, Ohio and the county maintenance department to do all of there heating/cooling issues. Also, they either need a \$1,400 heat exchanger for one of their units or replace the whole unit for \$7, 975.00 the current unit is 17 years old. If a new unit is purchased Johnsons would be able to look at the unit over the internet and will not be able to do with the old units. Mr. Miller question who would be responsible for paying for the repair JFS or the County Commissioners. Mr. Shryock stated that the County built that building with a bond years ago and then JFS leases that back from the County. This bond will be paid off in 2015. The questions being how soon will the building need to be expanded and upgraded. At this time Mr. Miller feels that his building has adequate space for their needs. Mr. Stahl feels that a new unit would be the most efficient. Mr. Shryock thinks that maybe we go with a bonding company and look at replacing all the units. Mr. Shryock asked what the long term arrangement is after the bond is paid would JFS continue to pay lease. Mr. Miller did not believe so but said that we would have to contact Mr. Batchelor on that issue. Mr. Miller stated that this is not an emergency situation so that there is time to consider all the options. Mr. Shryock asked that if the Commissioners decided to replace the heat exchanger at this time and wait until closer to the end of the bond repayment and then look at redoing the bond for a few more years to replace the heating units or any other building repairs at the that time. JFS is looking a leasing space on 432 Main Street for the Pretty Product lay off. They would have the space for three or four months for the employees off Pretty's to do their transition work. Mr. Miller would like permission to lease space. Mr. Shryock stated that the Commissioners do not have a problem with him moving forward. They have a lease prepared with Marlene Giffin and will have it looked at by Mr. Batchelor and will move forwarded quickly. Mr. Miller will get back with the Commissioner in January on the heating unit.
