Resolution 2009-48 - 1 Mill Children Services Levy Renewal

Mr. Terry Miller and Mrs. Mindy Fehrman attended the meeting to request the Commissioners sign a resolution to put a 1 mill Children Services Levy on the ballot in November. Mr. Lee made a motion, seconded by Mr. Fischer to sign Resolution 2009-48 declaring it necessary to levy a tax in excess of the ten mill limitation to support Children Services and the care, protection and placement of abused, neglected and dependent children. The levy is a renewal for a 5 year period in the amount of 1.0 mill.

Resolution 2009-49 - 2/10 Mill 911 Levy Renewal

Mr. Fischer made a motion, seconded by Mr. Lee to sign Resolution 2009-49 declaring it necessary to levy a tax in excess of the ten mill limitation to benefit and maintain the Installed Enhanced 911 Emergency Service for the citizens of Coshocton County, Ohio, ORC. 5705.191. The levy is a renewal for a 5 year period in the amount of 2/10 mill.

Resolution 2009-50 - Sale Tax Increase 1/2% Renewal
