#### **Buckeye Energy Brokers**

Mr. Arthur Denninger and Mr. Thomas Bellish attended the meeting to discuss savings for the county as well as the residents on their AEP and Columbia Gas bills. Mr. Denninger stated that there is a possibility of 3 different programs. One for the county buildings, one for the AEP customers and one for the Columbia gas customers. Mr. Shryock asked if there would be a need to do request for proposals for their service. Mr. Bellish stated that they are considered a professional service and there is no need for request for proposals. Mr. Shryock asked why there are only two counties involved in doing what they propose. Mr. Bellish stated that they normally only work out of the northeast area of the State and they already have something similar to this in place there. Mr. Lee stated that he does not feel there is very much Columbia gas service outside the city limits. Mr. Bellish stated that the cities will adopt their own resolutions for these savings. The Commissioners asked them to look at their current electric bills as well as their gas bills to determine if they can get them any savings. Mr. Derringer stated that there is no cost to the county for any of this. The Commissioners thanked them for attending.
