Discussion – ACA Reporting

Ms. Christine Sycks, County Auditor attended the meeting to discuss the 2016 ACA Reporting. Ms. Sycks stated that in 2015 we did a conversion and the information was not available for us to report in 2015. However, she has been assured that for 2016 we will be able to do the reporting ourselves. She is still working with SSI to confirm everything and she will also make certain the Commissioners are aware of what information will be needed.

Discussion – Public Defender Board

Mr. Jeff Mullen attended the meeting at the request of the Commissioners to discuss the Public Defender Board appointments. Mr. Shryock stated that we are required to have 2 attorneys on the board, but we do have difficulty in finding attorneys to serve. We have been informed that Mr. Mike McCullough was resigning in the near future. Mr. Lee stated that he is our appointment. He then asked if there has ever been a time when we did not have an attorney on the board. Mr. Mullen stated he can remember a short period where we did not have any attorneys on the board. Mr. Shryock stated that we have had conversation about getting an out of town attorney or we can fill the position with a local resident. Mr. Mullen stated that Ms. Linda Webber does serve on the board and she previously was a licensed attorney, but has let her license expire. Mr. Shryock asked if Mr. Mullen knew of any outside attorneys. Mr. Mullen stated that the only ones he knows are the ones appointed as Public Defender Attorneys. Mr. Shryock stated that we will take this under advisement and work on finding an appointment, but if he happens to hear of any interest, please keep us informed. The Commissioners thanked him for attending.


