The Commissioners stated that this will need to come from general funds as there is no funding available through EMA. They asked him to let them know what quote will be the most inexpensive and they will proceed. The Commissioners thanked him for attending.

Mr. Shryock then asked Mr. McMasters if the previous requirement for the NIMS was still in place. Meaning, that unless you have this training, your agency or entity will not be able to receive FEMA Funding without the training. Mr. McMasters assured the Commissioners that the NIMS training was not required but only recommended.




