Dog Wardens 2022 Annual Report

Mr. Rusty Dreher, Dog Warden and Mr. Ryan Conkle, Assistant Dog Warden attended the meeting to present the 2022 Annual Report which is a culmination of the 2022 weekly reports. There were 252 dogs picked up by the warden, 44 dogs brought in as strays, 79 euthanized, 496 dog licenses sold, 360 dogs sold, 166 dogs redeemed by owner, 288 dogs surrender by owner, 447 citations issued and 1794 calls handled for a total of \$20,453.00 in fees collected. In addition, there were 304 reports filed, 119 on those in the city and 185 in the county. In 2022 there were 9,332 standard licenses sold as well as 29,712 in miles driven for all dog wardens. Mr. Shryock thanked both gentlemen for their leadership.
