Ms. Jaime Freeman, Assistant JFS Director-IV-D Contracts

At 9:30 a.m. Ms. Jaime Freeman, Assistant JFS Director presented the Commissioners with the 2024 IV-D Contracts for Coshocton County Clerk of Courts in the amount of \$90,173.49, Coshocton County Common Pleas Court in the amount of \$46,416.02 and Coshocton County Juvenile Court in the amount of \$177,901.13. These three (3) contracts are renewed yearly, and are needed to initiate federal reimbursement for each entity. The 2024 overall value of the three (3) contracts have increased from 2023 vales. Commissioner Shryock thanked Ms. Freeman for her time and effort to complete the needed contracts.

Mr. Michael LaVigne- IT Director-Office 365 Contract & County Fiber Networks

At 9:45 a.m. Mr. Michael LaVigne, IT Director spoke to the Commissioners in regards to Office 365 and County Fiber Networks. Mr. LaVigne did reach out to other counties to find out if Horizon was being used, and he found that most counites surrounding Coshocton are current and active customers of Horizon. Currently, Coshocton County has both Spectrum and AT&T internet service with the majority of service through AT&T. Horizon is not currently in Coshocton County, but will be building to this area as all three (3) school districts have signed contracts with Horizon, the time frame for this would be 1-3 years out for service available. The Commissioners will think this over and get back with Mr. LaVigne as to what they decide to do. Additionally, Mr. LaVigne would like to sign a contract with Office 365 for a one-time fee of \$14,840.00 to begin the process of migrating each system to Office 365, the yearly fee will then be \$40,140.00 for a three (3) year term. The one-time fee of \$14,840.00 was a savings of \$5,000.00 from the previous quote. In closing, Mr. LaVigne reminded the Commissioners that a lot of other internet services would not be renewed as Office 365 will cover other areas as well, saving additional funds.
