DOG TAG POSTER CONTEST

The Dog Tag Poster Contest was created by Chris Sycks, Coshocton County Auditor to help promote community awareness of dog licensing. One of the responsibilities of the Auditor is to license all dogs in the county. We licensed nearly 9,000 dogs for 2017. Purchasing a tag for your dog is required by the State of Ohio. The tag has a number on it that identifies you as the owner should the dog get lost or separated from you.

CONTEST RULES:

1. There are two categories – 1st through 3rd grade and 4th through 6th grade. One winner will be selected from each category.
2. Draw and color a picture inside the box of any scene that includes a dog or dogs. Pencil, pen, markers, paint, or crayons are all acceptable media.
3. On the back of the poster, print your name, grade, school, and phone number
4. Mail or drop of the entry to the Auditor's Office at 349 Main Street, Coshocton, Ohio 43812 by Friday, November 10th. November 10th postmarks are acceptable.
5. Immediate family members of the employees of the Coshocton County Auditor's Office are not eligible to participate in the contest.
6. The judges will be the employees of the County Auditor's Office. All decisions of the judges are final.
7. Winners will be contacted by November 20th.
8. The two winners will have copies of their artwork displayed around the community and on the Auditor's website and social media advertising dog tag sales. The winners will also each receive a dog bowl, treats, and a toy for their (or somebody's) dog, and a \$10 Walmart gift card.
9. ALL entries will be displayed in the County Auditor's Office window at 349 Main Street during the month of January. If more space is needed, entries may be displayed in windows facing 4th Street as well.
