

COSHOCTON COUNTY "REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS & PROPOSAL ARCHITECTS/ENGINEERS FOR APPALACHIAN COUNTY GRANT PROGRAM"

Coshocton County Commissioners requests statements of qualifications and proposals from qualified individuals, companies, or organizations to provide architect/engineering services to assist Coshocton County in implementing ACGP Round 2 Development projects. The fee for architect/engineering services will be paid with ACGP funds.

The ACGP was created to fund sustainable, transformative projects in the 32 counties of the Appalachian region of Ohio. Included in Ohio House Bill 377, signed by Governor DeWine on June 28, 2022, the Appalachian Community Grant Program will be administered by the Ohio Department of Development (ODOD).

On May 20, 2024, the State Controlling Board approved OMEGA's application for Skip's Landing located in Coshocton County for \$6.7M. The project consists of street improvements, park improvements, and additional site landscaping and amenities. The project completion date is October 31, 2026. The Coshocton County Commissioners will enter into a sub-recipient agreement with OMEGA, and manage their project with the support of the chosen individual, company, or organization.

The **project architect/engineer** will work with OMEGA, state-procured planners, the construction manager at risk/ contractor (s), and the Coshocton County Commissioners. The project architect/engineer will assist the county with implementing the Skip's Landing project funded by the Appalachian Community Grant Program.

This Request for Qualifications (RFQ) and Proposals (RFP) is being issued by the Coshocton County Commissioners, which is the sole point of contact during the selection process.
