#### **Ohio Attorney General Opinion 2002-009**

The County Engineer is responsible for ensuring proper road drainage of county and township roadways in the county. It is the property owner's responsibility to construct and maintain access drives and culverts in compliance with the specifications and directions of the County Engineer in such a manner as to not hamper the road drainage system.

#### **GENERAL**

NORTH ↑

The safety of the traveling public shall be the paramount consideration governing any activity within the highway right-of-way. The permittee shall be responsible for the maintenance of a safe and passable roadway at all times, day and night, until his work is completed, at which time he shall leave the highway in a safe condition acceptable to the County Engineer and Board of Township Trustees. The applicant shall indemnify the county and township against liability and damage resulting from the proposed activity. Failure of the permittee to comply with all the requirements and special conditions of the permit shall be cause for revocation of the permit.
