**Budgets for 2022** – Ms. Weber moved and Dr. Poland seconded a motion to approve a budget of \$1,208.415.00 for the year ending December 31, 2022. – Roll call was unanimous – motion carried

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**Environmental** – Mr. Lonsinger reported that Zach Fanning, Environmental Health Director, had just received notice that the Mineral Fiber building was recently razed. The Company responsible for the demolition illegally dumped everything at Liddy's scrap yard on CR 621. Mr. Fanning will be sorting out the details and providing a full report to the board.

WIC – Mr. Lonsinger reminded that board that an Easter Bunny Drive-by is scheduled for March 19 from one until three at the fairgrounds. All are welcome.

**Accreditation** – Mr. Lonsinger shared that Jessica Burt, Accreditation Coordinator, shared with him that she has set a personal goal of completing one domain each month.

## Health Commissioner's Report - Mr. Lonsinger reported the following:

- ➤ One month ago, the Covid rates for Coshocton County were the second to lowest in the state, but last week jumped to the second to highest. Currently, we are 25<sup>th</sup> from the highest.
- A discussion ensued regarding how to encourage more residents to be vaccinated. Our county clinic is running very well, but only 68% of those vaccinated are county residents. Mr. Lonsinger showed a full page ad in the Beacon encouraging vaccination. Billboards were discussed.
- > We have received 500 at home test kits and have distributed them to schools and
- ➤ Ohio Senate Bill 22 has passed the senate and house, but Governor DeWine has promised to veto it. The bill restricts ODH and local authority relating to health crisis's and gives it to government.
