Coronavirus – Mr. Lonsinger reported that the case rate and the number of cases continue to climb sharply. The health department has a vaccination clinic each Friday in addition to the MCHC clinics.

MCHC – A written report was included in the Board packets.

WIC – Cindy Hilbish reported that the Immunization Event held at Coshocton Elementary School went well. The Baby Expo held at the fairgrounds was a drive through event and had 38 cars participate.

Accreditation – Mr. Lonsinger reported that he and Jessica Burt met with Commissioner Clark and Mayor Mills to discuss the health departments' joint accreditation application. The city health department stated that they are in full support of continuing with joint application process. The city health department is in the process of hiring new staff to fill a vacancy and to assist with accreditation

Health Commissioner's Report – Mr. Lonsinger reported that the health department will begin giving a third COVID vaccination shot (booster) to immunocompromised individuals. Standing orders were being prepared for those vaccination.
