Whereas previous orders were issued on or about March 17 & 26, 2020; April 13, 2020; May 11, 2020; August 3, 2020; and June 3, 2021, mandating the wearing of masks and other Covid-19 related restrictions in the Court of Common Pleas- Probate and Juvenile Divisions, located at 426 Main Street, Coshocton, Ohio; by all persons not otherwise exempted;



Whereas in examination of the current state of the previous health emergency and the medical interventions and treatments now readily available to the public, persons using the Coshocton County Court of Common Pleas, Probate and Juvenile Division have opportunities to voluntarily provide protection from infection for themselves and others;

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the previously issued masking & Covid-19 related orders shall be and are hereby rescinded and persons may enter the Coshocton County Court of Common Pleas, Probate and Juvenile Divisions without facial coverings, effective as of the date of the execution of this order.

Any individual may voluntarily utilize a facial covering by their personal and voluntary choice. The Court reserves the right to enforce building admission standards outlined in Local Probate and Juvenile Rules as posted on the Court website.


