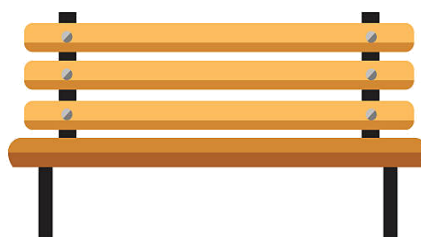
Bottle Caps to Benches—Collection Drive!
