CALL TO ORDER

President Don Wells called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. The attendance sheet is included with these minutes. A review of the attendance sheet showed 21 members present. The CCRPC membership is 30 members. Therefore, a quorum was present so this was an official meeting. This is the first full board meeting for 2025 with a quorum present.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Don led the Pledge of Allegiance.

MINUTES – FULL BOARD

The minutes of the last full board meeting dated November 18, 2024 were presented with the meeting agenda. Max Crown moved and Larry Boal seconded that the minutes be approved. Motion carried. The minutes will be posted on the CCRPC Website. A copy is attached.

FINANCIAL REPORT

The financial report through December 31 was presented. Dane Shryock moved and Alan Donaker seconded that the report be accepted. Motion carried. A copy is attached.

OLD BUSINESS

REVIEW OF CCRPC ACTIVITY THROUGH DECEMBER, 2024

A summary of CCRPC activity through the end of December was presented to the Board. A copy is attached.

MEMBERSHIP UPDATE

Including pending payments, the 2025 membership of the CCRPC stands at 30 members. A copy of the membership is attached.

ELECTION OF OFFICERS

President – Nominated – Don Wells – Larry moved and Brandy Burchett seconded to elect Don – Motion carried unanimously.

Vice President – Nominated – Larry Boal – Fred Wachtel moved and Dennis Balo seconded to elect Larry – Motion carried unanimously.

Executive Committee - Five members elected to serve on the Executive Committee in addition to one County Commissioner, the County Engineer, the CCRPC President and the CCRPC Vice President. Willing to serve on the Executive Committee are: Max Crown, Dennis Balo, Steve Hall, Alan Donaker, and Chuck Hathaway. Jesse Fischer moved and Dale Hartle seconded to elect this slate of candidates – Motion carried unanimously.

CONESVILLE INDUSTRIAL PARK UPDATE

Development work continues at the Conesville Power Plant.

The CCRPC has approved a proposed split to develop a site for a potential “Widget” factory. In addition, the owners, Conesville Industrial Park, are proposing to dedicate a public road for access to the new site. They will be using ORC 5553.31 – Dedication of land for road purposes for this dedication. Design and construction of the new road will be the developer’s responsibility. The County Engineer will review and approve the construction plans; inspect the construction of the road; and, when satisfied with the finished product, will recommend to the County Commissioners that they accept the improvement as a public road.

PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE BY-LAWS DEFINING A QUORUM

At the November 18, 2024 Board Meeting the proposed amendment to the By-Laws to change the definition of a quorum was accepted for consideration.

As required in the By-Laws, Fred Wachtel notified all the members of the CCRPC more than 15 days prior to the January 21 meeting that the amendment would be the subject of action at the January meeting.

Fred moved and Alan seconded that Article III – Meetings, Section 5: Quorums, First Paragraph be changed to read, “At any meeting of the commission a quorum shall consist of nine members of the current membership. At any meeting of the executive committee a quorum shall consist of a simple majority of the current members thereof.” The floor was then open for any questions, comments, or concerns. A few questions were raised and answered.

President Don Wells then called for a roll call vote. Results were: Dane Shryock – Yes; Gary Fischer – Yes; Bob Bigrigg – Yes; Fred Wachtel – Yes; Brandy Burchett – Yes; Larry Boal – Yes; Alan Donaker – Yes; Charles Hathaway – Yes; Max Crown – Yes; Cory Humphreys – Yes; Dale Hartle – Yes; Jesse Fischer – Yes; Rich Wheeler – Yes; Jeff Everhart – Yes; Dennis Balo – Yes; Dale Smith – Yes; Jim Schumaker – Yes; Steve Hall – Yes; Rodney Martin – Yes; Don Wells – Yes; John Blair – Yes. The membership of the CCRPC for 2025 is 30. There were 21 affirmative votes. The affirmative votes were 70 % of the membership. The By-Laws require at least a 60 % affirmative to approve an amendment. Therefore, the amendment is adopted.

NEW BUSINESS

None.

OTHER BUSINESS

- CCRPC Staffing post Fred – The current MOU with the County Engineers Office expires April 30, 2025. Fred plans to retire some time in 2025. His successor may not want the responsibility of managing the day-to-day business of the CCRPC. Therefore, alternative options need to be explored and a plan put in place before the end of April, 2025. The Executive Committee will meet on Monday, February 10 to develop some viable options for the CCRPC to consider.
- A few of the members expressed concern about how CCRPC information is shared with the membership. The Executive Committee will also discuss this item.

NEXT BOARD MEETING

There will be **no Board meeting in February.**

The next Board meeting is scheduled for **Monday, March 17, 2025 at 7:00 p.m.** in the Frontier Power Community Room. This meeting may be cancelled if no matters needing Board action. A notice will be sent out in early March.

CALL TO ORDER

Vice President Larry Boal called the meeting to order at 7:05 p.m. The attendance sheet is included with these minutes. A review of the attendance sheet showed 14 members present. The CCRPC membership is 27 members. Therefore, a quorum was present so this was an official meeting. This is the second full board meeting for 2024 with a quorum present.

OLD BUSINESS

REVIEW OF CCRPC ACTIVITY THROUGH OCTOBER, 2024

A summary of CCRPC activity through the end of October was presented to the Board. A copy is attached.

STANDARD POWER WASTEWATER TREATMENT LAGOONS

Fred Wachtel provided a report on the closure plan status. Aaron Pennington, OEPA, Division of Surface Water shared on September 11, 2024 that the Company will submit a closure plan for the reclamation of these facilities to OEPA this winter for review and approval. Dewatering is anticipated to occur in the 1st half of 2025.

CONESVILLE INDUSTRIAL PARK UPDATE

Demolition and reclamation work continue at the Conesville Power Plant.

The owners, in conjunction with the Coshocton Port Authority, have applied for infrastructure funds from the All Ohio Future Fund. The application includes money for access roads to the property and the extension of public water and sewer lines to industrial park. An announcement of funding is expected within the next few months.

The CCRPC has received an inquiry about splitting a 200 + acre parcel out of the Conesville Industrial Park property for a potential “Widget” factory. We are working with their surveyor to finalize the proposed parcel so it can be reviewed and approved.

PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE BY-LAWS DEFINING A QUORUM

At the January 22, 2024 Board Meeting President Dan Wells appointed a committee to prepare an amendment to change the definition of a quorum. Fred Wachtel presented the committee’s recommendation to change a quorum for the Commission from a simple majority of current members to nine members.

After discussion among the members present Alan Donaker moved and Dane Shryock seconded that proposed amendment be brought up for consideration at the next CCRPC meeting. Attached is proposed amendment along with the amendment process.

NEW BUSINESS

Ohio Department of Health Survey of Sewage Treatment Systems Program

As a result of a review of the Coshocton Health District Sewage Treatment System Program by the Ohio Department of Health we had to revise our split approval process.

OTHER BUSINESS

- Fred announced that sand is available at the County Engineer’s Office for use by public entities. There is no charge for the sand but the entity needs to make arrangements for hauling. Call the County Engineer’s Office if interested.
- Fred proposed that the CCRPC consider requiring surveyors to make a notation on their plat when the parcel they are creating is impacted by the 100-year floodplain. This will be visited at a future meeting.
- The Muskingum Watershed Conservancy District (MWCD) Partner in Watershed Management - Flood Mitigation Study for Lafayette and Oxford Townships was not selected for funding because the review committee felt the estimate was too low. Fred will reach out to discuss this matter with representatives of the MWCD.
- CCRPC Staffing post Fred – The current MOU with the County Engineers Office expires April 30, 2025. Fred plans to retire some time in 2025. His successor may not want the responsibility of managing the day-to-day business of the CCRPC. Therefore, alternative options need to be explored and a plan put in place before the end of April, 2025. Fred and a few others will work on some viable options for the CCRPC to consider.

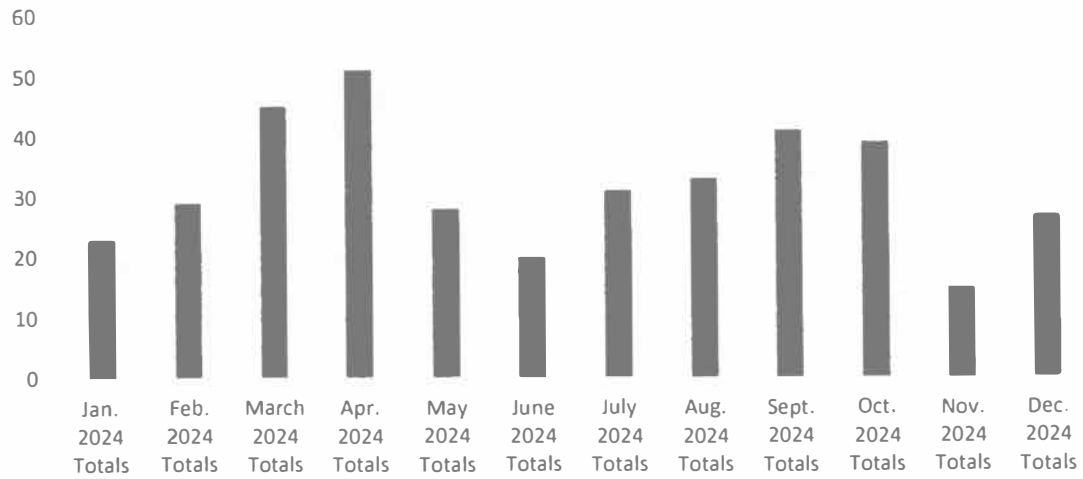

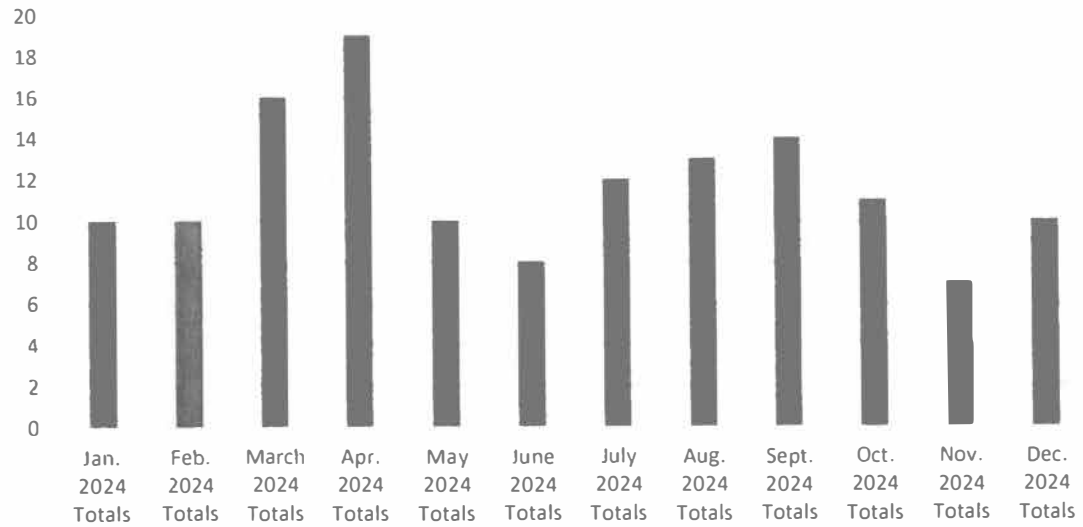
