<u>Coshocton County Subdivision Regulations Update –</u> Recommendations from the board on possible updates/revisions to subdivision regulations. Possible revisions to Private Road Subdivision standards.

Discussion began about the use of private road subdivisions and possible use of right of ways in lieu of private roads in some situations. Discussion was also had about possibly changing regulations so that adjoiner only splits less than a certain size can be done without the need for a split review. Josh asked the group to come with recommendations that can be given to the full board or commissioners.

Other Business

Sherri Bates and Shawn Bates were the only public visitor present at the meeting. They brought up an ongoing issue that they have with Linton Township. This issue did not pertain to CCRPC but was strictly a Linton Township issue. The committee listened to the issue and some members offered guidance or advice on the issue but reiterated to the Bates's that the CCRPC had no authority with the issue that they were presenting.

The MOU with the County Engineer's Office was presented and signed by Don Wells, CCRPC President, and Joshua Kempf, Coshocton County Engineer. The MOU was previously approved by a full board vote at the April 21, 2025 meeting.
