This form is NOT an adoption contract and does not automatically result in approval. Please allow 72 hours for volunteers to process this application. Don't hesitate to reach out to us regarding its status at any time.

The veterinary reference will be checked and verified. The animals you list must include veterinarian that fixed them as confirmation of spays and neuters are our only criteria. We do not require certain fencing or other stipulations beyond traditional, responsible pet ownership--but we do require that you have fixed animals who are routinely cared for by a veterinarian. If you are a first time pet owner, include a parent or guardians veterinary records to confirm history, you may also include a personal reference. Landlords are contacted for permission of homed animal prior to release. Veterinary information checks help us to protect the animals we care for and love, and ensure the most successful adoption we can. We invest a great deal in them while they're with us, and ask the same of you.

To adopt from this shelter, all animals must be fixed in your household, unless they are under 4 months of age. Your reference must include the information for us to confirm this.

This brief questionnaire is to learn more about you and match accordingly to the animal of interest and/or future shelter pets. We have no affiliation with the Coshocton County Humane Society. To apply to adopt from there you must visit the website they provide.

We send many animals to rescue as space is of constant concern. This is an open admission animal shelter who receives thousands of animals in need each year. We are a volunteer based, rural area, dog pound and open admit cat shelter. We do not have the luxury of lengthy waits. Please submit your form quickly and promptly for best chance of consideration, please also feel free to submit and include the pet you are interested in, in detail, and contact us as animals of interest present. We are a source shelter, and utilize rescues and partnering shelters for resources and movement. We trust our partners and depend on them each week to save lives. Please feel free to ask about animal of interest and what rescue or partnering shelter, so that you can apply direct.
