2022 Coshocton SWCD Cover Crop Program Application deadline July 13th 2022

Things you will need to submit with your application

- Aerial maps of fields being applied for
- Soil Test one test for every 25 acres, no older than 4 years
- Documentation of nutrients to receive 20 points Date applied, product or analysis, and application rate.

Cost share rate is \$12.00/acre with a cap of 200 approved acres per applicant. Unless fields are above a MWCD lake

Soil test <u>MUST</u> be supplied to SWCD staff to be eligible. Test must be within the last 4 years with at least 1 test for every 25 acres applied.

If receiving points for having nutrient application records, producers <u>MUST</u> supply the SWCD staff with the current crop record for each field. Minimum requirement are date applied, product or analysis, and rate.

- This program is funded by the Muskingum Watershed Conservancy District. Technical and administrative support is provided by the Ohio Department of Agriculture Division of Soil and Water Resources.
- Applications will follow a ranking process.
- Cap of 200 acres unless fields are above the approved list of MWCD lakes
- Plantings that do not follow NRCS standards such as seeding rates, dates and approved methods will not be eligible for this program
- Seed must be tested for germination and weed seed content by ODA to be used in this program
- Plantings that are total failures due to herbicide carryover will not receive the approved cost share for that field(s)
- SWCD will be notified within 5 days of field(s) being planted.
- Provide any necessary requested information to Coshocton SWCD as needed.
- Due to conditions beyond the SWCD control, the District in no way guarantees, either expressed or implied the successful establishment of a crop through this program.
- The participants shall hold Coshocton SWCD and its assigned harmless from all damages for injuries or death to persons or property as a result of this program.
- Coshocton SWCD and its assigned reserve the right modify this program.
- Participant gives Coshocton SWCD and its assigned permission to enter and exit property as needed to verify completion of this program prior to payment. (site checks, gathering data, etc.)
- Coshocton SWCD programs and services are conducted without regard to race, color, national origin, sex, age, marital status, sexual orientation, handicap or other prohibited criteria.
- Producers enrolled in the program with two (2) consecutive years of zero (0) approved fields being planted and turned in to the SWCD, will be capped at 50 acres approved for 2022.
