Mr. Brian Simmons/Ms. Janette Wierzbecki, W.E. Quicksall & Associates

Mr. Brian Simmons, County Water & Waste Water Department, Fred Wachtel, County Engineer and Ms. Janette Wierzbecki, W.E. Quicksall and Associates attended the meeting to discuss Lake Park/CR 495 Water Extension and the Master Meter on CR 55. Mr. Shryock stated that we have requested the help of W.E. Quicksall for help in submission of theses projects. Ms. Wierzbecki stated that she has prepared resolutions for the submission of these projects to OPWC. Mr. Wachtel stated that he feels that he Commissioners should continue the line on CR 495 as he is concerned with water loss. Mr. Wachtel stated that this will be an OPWC Loan for 0% interest. Mr. Shryock stated that he feels they have two options, they could put a meter pit in at the private water line or they can include the approximately ¼ additional miles in the loan. Mr. Shryock asked if there is any additional grant funding available to put toward this project Ms. Wierzbecki stated that the only other grant monies available would possibly be CDBG. The Commissioners determined that at this time they should include the additional homes on CR 495. Ms. Wierzbecki stated that she will get with Mr. Simmons and once they determine the estimated cost of the projects, they will get back with the Commissioners. The Commissioners thanked everyone for attending.
