Coshocton County Subdivision Regulations

Mr. James Hartzler and Mrs. Tiffany Swigert, Regional Planning Director attended the meeting to discuss the County's Subdivision Regulations. Mr. Lee was absent from the meeting to attend a Board of Revision Meeting. Mr. Hatzler stated that he first spoke with Tiffany about this issue back in the fall of 2008. He stated that the subdivisions in place date back to 1968 and he feels they should be amended. He would like to get a group of about 10 people together for about 3-4 meetings then he can work closely with them to come up with a draft document of the Subdivision Regulations. He stated that he has worked with many counties and what he has found is that the way that the regulations are planned is going to be a lot different than in other counties as we are a very rural county. Every county is in fact unique and the regulations must be done for each individual county because of the uniqueness. He discussed the method of determining the regulations for each county. He went over the authority given to establish these regulations. He stated that the whole process takes approximately 3-4 months to develop a document to present to the Commissioners. Mr. Shryock thanked Mr. Hartzler for attending today. He stated that he feels that Coshocton County should not have a Regional Planning Commission and have a County Planning Commission instead. Mr. Hartzler stated that he agrees with Mr. Shryock's assessment. He feels the Commissioners should seriously consider changing to a County Planning Commission. Mr. Shryock then stated that the Planning Commission would like to have the Subdivision Regulations updated. He stated that we are looking into possibly applying for grant funding to do this. At this time, we have not heard back from the grant funding agency. So, before we even approach this issue, we need to know an estimated cost for this project. Mr. Hartzler stated that he feels things will work out better if there is a sole funding force in the county. Normally the cost to create subdivision regulation is right around \$10,000.00 He stated that he would be willing to do this for \$7,500 - \$8,000 if there is a sole funding source. Mr. Shryock stated that at this time, \$10,000 is a huge number to the Commissioners. Although things are looking somewhat brighter, the Commissioners will need to discuss this issue. He thanked Mr. Hartzler for his time and stated that they will get back with him in the near future.
