#### **Energy Savings Grant**

Mr. Marti Miller, Mr. Jeff Feasby, ESG, Mr. Mark Zappe, Mr. Tom Erlewein, Johnson Controls and Mr. TJ Justice attended the meeting to discuss the County's Energy Savings Grant. Mr. Justice stated that we were awarded a \$479,238.00 grant that the County has received from the Energy Saving Stimulus Funding. Mr. Justice stated that there are 4 items that are needed to be attached and sent to the State of Ohio. He read a brief narrative that was sent to the state when applying for the funding that basically describes what the Commissioners applied for. He will send that if that is alright with the Commissioners. He read off the addresses for the buildings that are included in the application. They would also like to know of any minor changes that were proposed. They require that a milestone schedule be submitted as well. Once we get this information to them, and they are satisfied with it, we will then get the grant application and proceed from there. Mr. Justice is asking the State if we will be required to perform another RFQ Process or if the one we did will be sufficient. Mr. Miller stated that he feels it will be adequate as they have done work for Hancock County and they approved their RFP. Mr. Justice stated there will be things that need to be reported in the way of job activity that we will need built into this project. Also, we will be required to report the energy savings itself. Mr. Miller stated that there will be an ongoing relationship with the county to measure and verify the energy savings obtained. Mr. Miller asked that the Commissioners sit down with him to determine exactly what projects they would like to see completed. Mr. Lee stated that we had submitted the whole project, but the State took out the water savings portion. Mr. Miller stated that this is not an extremely large project, and should be completed fairly quickly. Mr. Justice stated that the budget he submits to the state will be less the water savings portion. Mr. Shryock stated that our board has been fairly aggressive when applying for these grant applications. If it were not for ESG we would not have been able to put this grant application together. We did go through the competitive RFP Process for this project. So, at this time we are waiting to hear from the State as to whether they will accept our RFP Process or not to proceed with ESG. Mr. Justice stated that he hopes to hear something today. He then stated that because of the Commissioners pro-activeness Coshocton County has received significant dividends for this community that will pay greatly in the future. The Commissioners thanked them for attending.

#### Johnson Controls

Mr. Mark Zappe and Mr. Tom Erlewein, Johnson Controls attended the meeting to discuss the possibility of the RFP Process being re-opened for the Energy Savings Project. If the RFP's are required to be done again, they would be interested in submitting a proposal. Mr. Zappe asked if they do not get to submit an RFP for the County Energy Savings Project, would they be able to talk with the Board of DD about some of their issues. The Commissioners stated that they will need to talk with the Board of DD to determine if they are interested in any of these things.
