If the dog is unlicensed, they can license the dog or charge a fee of \$25.00 per dog. He explained that other counties do this and don't seem to have any problems with it. Mr. Shryock stated that if he remembers correctly, we may need to have a public hearing, but he is not certain. Mrs. Beck will look into what we need to do and get back with the Commissioners. The Commissioners thanked them for attending.

Litter Recycling Grant – Mr. Jeff Wherley

Mr. Jeff Wherley attended the meeting to discuss the grant monies from the state for the recycling trailers. He stated that he has been getting a lot of requests for assistance from many of the principles at the local schools. So, he is looking at some different type trailers that we might utilize. These types of trailers only take two types of materials. He stated that we can utilize these roll-offs in addition to the alleycat trailers that we have. He feels this might give us an opportunity to expand what we are doing with the recycling program. The Commissioners feel that this would give the recycling some different options. They are in favor of Jeff proceeding on this path. The Commissioners thanked him for attending.
