Omnicity – Update

Mrs. Jordan Seib, Mr. Mike LaVigne, Mr. Stu Johnson, Ms. Missy Zickel and Mr. Dave Weddell, Omnicity attended the meeting for an update. Mr. Johnson stated that he is official and has completed his third week with Omnicity. They have made an effort to keep all the information updated and out to the public. They are launching a new marketing strategy for Coshocton County. They hope to install many more installations here in Coshocton. They are offering one month free service for anyone activated within the next month. They have installed 22 new residents in the last month. So far this month, in March, they have installed 9. He will continue to update the Commissioners on these installs. Mr. Dave Weddell stated that Omnicity feels that they now have the proper team in place to proceed with installations as they had originally planned. He realizes that in the past they have not been able to produce as they would have liked to, but he feels that will change now. He then stated that they are working on installation of the last two fire stations and need a little help with a tower at the State Highway Garage in Canal Lewisville. The Commissioners gave him the number to Joseph Rutheford, Deputy Director, ODOT District 5. The Commissioners thanked them for their report.


