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Investment Portfolio

Mrs. Janet Donaker, County Treasurer presented the Commissioners with her Investment Portfolio. She stated that she has had a couple CD's mature and can only get .6% interest on the renewals. The Commissioners thanked her for attending.

W.E. Quicksall - Contract Amendment - CR 495 Waterline Extension

Mr. Mike Jones attended the meeting to present the Commissioners with a contract amendment for the extension of the CR 495 waterline an additional 650 feet. The Commissioners stated that they will send the document over to the Prosecutor's Office for him to review. The Commissioners thanked him for attending.

Palmer Energy Presentation

Mr. Bill Bradish, and Ms. Sandy Murphy, Palmer Energy attended the meeting to discuss the CCAO negotiated energy rates for electric. He stated that RFP's will be going out for all counties in a few weeks. He would like to include Coshocton County in this request. He then stated that CCAO has asked them to consider allowing Palmer Energy to evaluate the audits that other companies are doing for the county. He stated that they have negotiated a 3% discount for generation costs to residents as well as governments and businesses. In order for this to be approved, this must be placed on the ballot. They are asking that the Commissioners help them in informing Townships and local villages that qualify as this will only affect Ohio Power customers. Mr. Bradish stated that the company offering the discount is First Energy Solution and they are a division of Ohio Edison. Mr. Lee questioned where they would get their generation as he cannot see where they are able to save monies. Also, he is concerned that if this would pass on the ballot, then residents that don't choose to continue where they are would automatically be moved for three years to this new company. Mr. Lee then asked if we allow them to solicit RFP's for the county facilities, would this affect residents at all. Mr. Bradish stated that the resident's portion of the savings must be passed on the ballot before it would be effective. The Commissioners stated that they will participate in the RFP for the county facilities. The Commissioners thanked them for attending.
