Mrs. Corder stated that when she submitted her conservative revenue numbers she has since received additional information on revenue and will be adjusting those in the near future. She anticipates that the revenue numbers will increase a little bit. Mr. Lee made a motion, seconded by Mr. Shryock to sign Resolution 2011-40 to submit the Annual Estimated Budget for the fiscal year commencing January 1, 2012 for the consideration of the Coshocton County Budget Commission.
