The Commissioners stated that they will contact the Prosecuting Attorney to proceed in this manner. He also stated that Mr. Jim Karr at the Hydrologic Station asked him to have the entity that won the bid (Yoder Lumber) cut the timber in section 4 last as they want to reestablish the watershed in that area. Mr. Lee stated that we did not specify that in our bid information so we will be unable to do that. Mr. Berry stated that he will make certain Mr. Karr is aware of this.

Mr. Minet stated that he wanted to let the Commissioners know that beginning May 20th is EMS Week. He also stated that the Coshocton County EMS did win another STAR Award in Region 6. Out of countless nominations Coshocton County was selected. He is very honored to receive this award for the 5th time. It is the highest recognition an individual can receive.
