2nd Public Hearing-FY 2012 Formula

At 9:00 a.m. the 2nd Public Hearing for the 2012 Formula Projects was held. Mrs. Robin Schonauer stated that the county will receive \$96,000.00 in Formula funding for grant year 2012. The following projects will be included in the grant application that will be presented to the Ohio Department of Development: \$11,800 – Tuscarawas Twp., Street Improvements- Street Signs, \$8,400 – Village of West Lafayette, Street Improvements-Street Signs, \$9,700 – Village of West Lafayette-Fire Protection Fac./Fire Hydrants, \$46,900 – Village of Warsaw-Street Improvements/Resurface various streets, \$19,200-Administration/Fair Housing. She also stated that the grant application was due on June 22, 2012. There were no other persons in attendance. At 9:15 a.m. Mr. Shryock closed the public hearing.

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Investment Portfolio

Mrs. Janet Donaker, County Treasurer presented the Commissioners with her Investment Portfolio. She stated that the legislation has implemented a new requirement that the County Treasurer will be required to submit a monthly report on our investments and the Auditor of State will post them on their website for everyone to view. Portfolio Productions has advised her on the information she should report on her monthly report to the State Auditor. She reported that the investment income revenue account has collected 75% of the annual projection. She also stated second half tax bills have been mailed and will be due July 13, 2012. The Commissioners thanked her for attending.
