Solid Waste District 2013 Grant Applications

Mr. Steve Lonsinger, Mr. Zack Fanning and Mr. Jeff Wherley attended the meeting to discuss the 2013 Solid Waste District Grant Applications. Mr. Lonsinger stated that he is requesting \$48,154.95 for the Solid Waste Enforcement and they are requesting \$1,500 for a Small Dump Cleanup. They requested \$50,000 or so last year in just the enforcement and since that request is less this year, they will also request the funds for the small dump cleanup. The Commissioners signed a letter of support for Mr. Lonsinger. Mr. Wherley stated that he is going to request approximately \$128,000 and for the countywide recycling, he is requesting approximately \$104,000 because of some very necessary repairs to the trailers. He will come back in a couple weeks with the exact numbers. Hel stated that he may also have to come back for some additional funding for the collections. He stated that for each event, he spends approximately \$4,000 in advertising, flyers,
