Discussion - Engineer's Insurance Premiums

Mrs. Tiffany Swigert attended the meeting to discuss the Knox County Commissioners and the Knox County Engineer's Lawsuit about paying insurance premiums for the Engineer's vehicles and property. The lawsuit went to the Ohio Supreme Court and it was found in favor of the Knox County Commissioners. The actual lawsuit is Stockberger et al., v. Henry, Slip Opinion No. 2012-Ohio-5392.1This will now give the County Commissioners the ability to charge back the County Engineer for his liability, vehicle and property insurance. The Coshocton County Commissioners discussed their options and determined that at this time for the 2012/2013 premiums this board has no intention of charging the Coshocton County Engineer for these costs that have been previously paid out of the general fund. In the future, the Commissioners believe it will be in the best interest of the Coshocton County tax payers not to charge back those funds to the Engineer unless the County General fund would decrease in revenue and prohibit us from making those payments. As the Commissioners feel the MVG Funds should be used in the best interest of the tax payers for roads, bridges and the running of the Engineer's Office which is a critical part of Coshocton County's infrastructure. With that being said,

Mr. Lee made a motion, seconded by Mr. Fischer to not charge the County Engineer for his property and vehicles insurance as long as the general fund can sustain this action.
