Coshocton City/County Park District – 2012 Budget

Mrs. Lori Everhart, Dr. David Erwin and Mr. Roger Moore attended the meeting to discuss the Coshocton County Park District's 2012 budget. Mrs. Everhart stated they met with the Commissioners in the summer sometime. At that time, they did not need any assistance with funding. However, they have been doing fairly well being able to pay the bills and such. They have been expecting a reimbursement check from FEMA. They have now been told that FEMA will not process anymore applications until sometime in mid-January. They were expecting \$26,000 some odd dollars. They are currently at \$12,237.00. They will not be able to get through the end of the year with the bills they have remaining. She is short about \$7,700 to get to the end of the year. Last year they had a \$37,000 carryover. She will have no monies to start out 2013 as well. She stated that the Commissioners said they would be willing to entertain a request for funding. She stated that they are requesting funds to help get through the end of the year as well as possibly through January. She is requesting at least \$17,000. Mr. Lee asked if there were any other options or sources of funding. Mrs. Everhart stated that they could go to a foundation, but she didn't think that they could get funding very quickly. She also stated that they could ask the Friends of the Park, but then that would take away from the funding for the levy. Mr. Fischer asked if they were certain they would get the funding from FEMA. Mrs. Everhart stated that at this point the application has been approved in the first step of the process and is at the next step. Mr. Shryock asked if this is money that will be loaned and reimbursed, or is she just asking for funds. She stated that her first request would be just for the funding without paying it back, but if the Commissioners are not willing to do that she would reimburse the funds from the FEMA monies. She stated in the last 3 years the budget has gone from \$800,000 to \$496,000. She doesn't feel they can cut anything else. She stated that she feels they have done everything they can to reduce expenses any way possible. She stated that once the levy passes, they will have another tough year ahead because they won't have the levy dollars until 2014. Mr. Shryock stated that we need to have some discussion with our Budget Director and will get back with them before the end of the day. We are being very conservative with our funds right now because of a pending lawsuit with OPERS. They thanked the Commissioners for their time.

Discussion - Park District

The Commissioners had general discussion on the ability to give the Park District Funds. The Commissioners decided that they would give the Park District \$12,000. Of that, \$7,700 will be a grant and \$4,300 will need to be repaid when they receive their FEMA monies. The thought process behind this is that the \$4,300 loan will give them time to find additional funding through the foundations or other grants.
