Discussion - Pearl/Fresno Pumps

Mr. Fred Wachtel attended the meeting to discuss the Pearl/Fresno Pumps. Mr. Wachtel stated they have received the preliminary findings for the Pearl/Fresno Pumps. The problem appears that the revised plans to go from a 6 inch line to a 4 inch line. It doesn't appear that anyone checked to make sure the pumps could push the solids through a 4 inch line. That seems to be the problem. This would appear to be the reason those pumps are not functioning as they should be. He stated that they cannot find in any of their specifications that they re-evaluated to determine if the pumps could handle the smaller 4 inch line. He would like to contact GGC Engineer's to determine if they did do any research to determine if this smaller line would affect the pumps. Mr. Wachtel stated that since the pumps have to work more often, this will hasten the life of the pumps as they will have to work much harder than originally thought. Mr. Fischer stated that this issue is more about longevity as well as efficiency. He asked if he has any idea the cost to fix this issue. Mr. Wachtel stated that at this time it has just been determined what the problem is and he is not certain the remedy for the situation yet. He feels we need to determine what can be done to correct the issue and what will be the most cost effective remedy. The Commissioners stated that they do not have an issue contacting GGC Engineer's to see if they have any findings on the change in the size of the line.
