# OSU - Hydrologic Station

Mr. Ken Scaife, Mr. Jim Buxton, Ms. Emily Adams and Mr. Steven Slack, OSU attended the meeting to give an update on the Hydrologic Station. Mr. Lee welcomed everyone and turned the meeting over to Mr. Slack. Mr. Slack stated that they are here to give an update on what is happening at the Hydrologic Station. He stated that they are still interested in the Federal Property out there. Once the property moves to the General Services Agency (GSA), they will then again try to acquire that property through GSA. At this time they still have a lease in place with the Federal Government. They do not anticipate any issues, but if anything would come up, they will be in contact with the Commissioners. These things just take some time. He then spoke about the projects that they have underway at the Hydrologic Station. He presented the Commissioners with an overview of the programs. He reviewed the status of each project and when the project termination dates will be. He then reviewed the Corn Cap Project (CSCAP). This is a multi-state project. In this project the same experiment is being run in several different regions to give them information on how weather events affect these crops. This is a five year project and they are in the middle of the project. Mr. Shryock asked what the plans are for the CSCAP program which is located on County Property, if the program is not complete when the lease is up. Mr. Slack stated that they will like to try to work something out with the Commissioners on this program. They are hoping to start conversations about the lease if possible. Mr. Lee asked if they intend to lease all of the county property. Mr. Slack stated that they are willing to work with the county to lease all or just a portion of the property. Mr. Lee asked if they are happy with the present agreement that we have in place at this time. Mr. Slack stated that they are happy with an annual agreement at this time as well. The Commissioners would like to offer a one year extension on the lease we have in place at this time. Mr. Slack stated that he will take the information back to his real estate people and get that extension moving. The Commissioners thanked them for attending.

Licking County Roll-off/Trailers

Mr. Jeff Wherley and Mr. Tim Beck, Recycling and Litter Prevention attended the meeting to discuss the roll-offs as well as the trailers that are available in Licking County. Mr. Lee then stated that he feels we should try to get a truck as a back-up as well. Mr. Wherley stated that they do have some alleycats (trailers) that may become available in the near future. He stated that they would like to make the Commissioners aware of the opportunity here. The Commissioners stated that they would really like to have a back-up truck and then look at the alleycats that will become available later. Mr. Wherley stated that he will talk with Perry and Fairfield Counties to determine if this is possible. The Commissioners thanked them for attending.
