Discussion - Mr. Jeff Wherley - Deer Disposal

Mr. Jeff Wherley attended the meeting to discuss the County's Deer Disposal. Mr. Wherley stated that we do have monies for the deer collection this year. With the closure of the landfill, it creates a problem of where to take these deer. He said he has looked at several options, and determined that the best option is to take the deer to Dover for disposal. He stated that he will need to get a new person to do this as the individual he has now is not interested in traveling that far. Mr. Lee asked if other counties offer this service. Mr. Shryock asked if this is the responsibility of the County Engineer. Mr. Wherley stated that it really isn't the responsibility of the Engineer or Township Trustees and he is not certain what other counties do. Mr. Shryock stated that in the past, we had money to fund this program. He feels that at this point, the Solid Waste District may not have the funds to continue this. Mr. Shryock stated that he feels we need to determine if it is our responsibility if this qualifies as a solid waste disposal issue, or if it is some other entities responsibility. Mr. Wherley stated that the simplest thing would be to continue the service until the funds are no longer available and then do it no longer. The Commissioners asked Mr. Wherley to find someone to do it this year and then they will reconsider for next year. The Commissioners thanked Jeff for the information.
