Mr. Ike Reger, County Maintenance Supervisor attended the meeting to discuss road going to the leased Head Start Building. Mr. Shryock stated that the Commissioners had the County Engineer look at the road and he stated that the roadway would need to have full depth reclamation. This is quite costly and since we will not be able to get funding to do this until 2017 the Commissioners have decided they would like to use HPM (High Price Material) to maintain the roadway until they can get the funding in place to fix the roadway. The County Engineer, Fred Wachtel stated that he will partner with the Commissioners to haul some of the HPM for them. Mr. Reger stated that he has spoken with Mr. Wachtel and he will work with him to get the HPM. Mr. Fischer stated that we have a mutual aid agreement with the Village of Warsaw and they will let us utilize their roller. Mr. Reger stated that he thinks he can get some cold mix material here locally cheaper. The Commissioners stated that they would like to have Mr. Reger talk with Ed Robinette from the Village of Warsaw as he uses the HPM product to learn more about it, and to make certain if the product can be utilized over a period of time. Mr. Reger stated that he will talk to Mr. Robinette and get back with the Commissioners.


Pay Application No. 2 –SR 751 Waterline Extension
