They are wondering what research is still going on and for how long. Mr. Shryock explained that our Lease Agreement with OSU does not end until March 31, 2106. OSU is doing projects on both our property as well as the federally owned property. We do not know if they will want to continue the lease further at this point but, it is the intent of the Commissioners to continue the lease with OSU as long as OSU wants to. The Commissioners thanked them for their interest, but stated that at this time we will not make any changes.
