Discussion - Cardboard Recycling - Mr. Jeff Wherley

Mr. Jeff Wherley attended the meeting at the request of the County Commissioners. Mr. Shryock stated that with the closing of West Rock, this will have a huge impact on the county recycling. Mr. Wherley stated that he is for some county owned property we can utilize the trailers we got from Licking County and collect cardboard only in them for county residents. Mr. Shryock asked if the trailers have a cover on them. Mr. Wherley stated that they do have a lid. Mr. Shryock stated that from what we understand West Rock will not be taking cardboard after this week. Mr. Wherley stated that it was his understanding that they would be taking cardboard until November 25th. He will double check this to make certain. Mr. Shryock then stated that those containers at West Rock are emptied approximately 3 times per week and there are 3 containers there. So, that will be a lot of trips for us. Mr. Wherley stated that he has spoken to Mr. Jerry Stenner at the City of Coshocton and told him that they will need a private hauler to come in and take care of that. He told him that Waste Management would be the logical choice as they do have a contract for trash removal and recycling. Mr. Wherley will look in to all options as the Commissioners feel this will end up being an issue for the county. The Commissioners thanked Mr. Wherley for attending and look forward to hearing from him soon.

2016 Health Benefits Renewal

Mr. Michael Zaluski, Specialty Insurance and Financial Services attended the meeting to present the 2016 Health Benefits Plan Renewal. Mr. Zaluski then reviewed the renewal he shopped out for the county. He recommends that the county stay with the carrier they are with as well as the stop-loss carrier. There will be no change to the benefits and the overall cost will be very similar to last year. The Commissioners stated that they will follow Mr. Zaluski's recommendation and continue with Mutual Health Services as our Third Party Administrator with the Medical Mutual Network and IAORe as our Stop-loss carrier with no increase in the monthly premium costs. The Commissioners thanked Mr. Zaluski for attending.
