Discussion – TANF Funding

Mr. Doug Schonauer, Lt. Jim Crawford, Mrs. Robin Schonauer, Mrs. Melinda Fehrman and Mr. Danny Brenneman attended the meeting to discuss some possible TANF funding to help in the general fund. Mrs. Fehrman stated that she had discussed the need for local funds from the Commissioners in 2017. She stated that she reached out to other general fund departments to determine if there is any way that she could use TANF funding for some of the services offered in the general fund. Her hope is because the Foster care expenses have increased significantly that they may be able to shift some funds for public use into the Foster care expenses. She met with the Sheriff's Office and Juvenile Court to see what they could come up with. She then presented the Commissioners with a spreadsheet that shows what obligations the general fund has for Juvenile Court as well as the Sheriff's Office. She hopes that being able to utilize TANF funding for some of these services will alleviate the general fund dollars to go toward the Foster care expenses. She reviewed the spreadsheet and explained how she thinks this process would work for the Juvenile Court as well as the Sheriff's Office funding. She stated that some of the programs with the Sheriff's Office will be new and have never been in place before. She then stated that she does feel that the funding will be in place for a while but she cannot predict the future. She wants to suggest that the Commissioners give DJFS \$75,000.00 including the \$26,000 they are already funding at this time in 2017 and she will give TANF funding to programs in the general fund through Juvenile Court and the Sheriff's Office. Mr. Lee asked if they got permission to do this from the State. Mrs. Fehrman stated that they have approval from the State for all the suggested TANF funding. However, the new position at the Sheriff's Office would not be certain of approval until after the auditing process takes place. Mr. Lee then stated that he wanted it to be clear that we are not utilizing the TANF funding by taking it away from another program. Mr. Brenneman stated that they are not utilizing the entire TANF allocation and this will utilize those extra dollars. Mrs. Fehrman stated that they continually look at the programs in place to make sure they meet all the TANF requirements. Mr. Lee then asked if this plan would need to hire new employees and Lt. Crawford stated that one position would be a new one and the other programs would be covered by employees already in place. Mr. Fischer asked how long it will be until the State approves the County with the Interdiction Detective since this is the one area that has not been previously approved. Mrs. Fehrman then explained that there are certain TANF qualifying programs and she feels that as long as the monthly invoices are appropriately documented there will be no issues at all. Mrs. Fehrman stated that she really appreciates the Commissioners willingness to look at this possibility as she feels this will help make a difference with all these drug issues that we have in the community. The Commissioners thanked everyone for attending and stated that they will get back with everyone very soon.
