Courthouse Coverage

Ms. Ginny Shrimplin, Ms. Allie Redmond, CORSA, Mr. Don Parkhill, Mr. Tony West, Jacobs Vanaman Agency and Mrs. Tiffany Swigert, Coshocton County Safety and Loss Control attended the meeting. Mr. Parkhill stated that there has been a change in industrial appraisals. They have some new options for Courthouses. Ms. Redmond reviewed some of coverage options available and how they will affect the county in cost for liability coverage. She stated that we have always had replacements costs, but now we have the option of choosing reproduction costs. Replacement costs would cover modern day replacements whereas reproduction costs would be original or similar material replacement of the loss. The difference in the cost of the coverage is \$3,694.00 for the reproduction cost vs. the replacement cost. The Commissioners stated that they would like to go with the reproduction and pay the additional funds. The Commissioners thanked them for attending.

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Palmer Energy Update

Mr. Bob Snavely, Palmer Energy attended the meeting to update the Commissioners on the CCAO Energy Savings Program. He presented the Commissioners with an electric savings analysis since 2013.
