Mr. Carey stated that they are short a couple part-time driver positions. He stated that he has received several resumes and he plans to hire at least one maybe two additional part-time drivers. The Commissioners thanked him for his update.

Proposals - Body Scanner Room Expansion - Sheriff's Office

Mr. Dennis Lowe, Mr. Carter Paul, Paul Construction, Sheriff Timothy Rogers, Lt. Jim Crawford, and Lt. Chip Udischas attended the meeting. There was one proposal presented and it was \$51,175.00, which is over the \$50,000.00 threshold. The Commissioners asked that we contact the prosecutor to determine how to proceed.
