CORSA –Coshocton County Appraisals


Ms. Ali Redmond, CORSA, Mr. Tony West, and Ms. Jill Carnes, Jacobs Vanaman and Mrs. Brooke Alverson, Safety and Loss Control attended the meeting to discuss the County Property Appraisals. Ms. Redmond then reviewed the appraisal numbers and values. She stated that the new value (\$78,421,564.00) has decreased from the last appraisal by \$1,364,224.00. 27 counties facilities were appraised with an average increase 6.48% overall increase. However, Coshocton County's appraisal decreased by 1.74%. The county added 9 items and had 37 buildings with values less than \$100,000. Ms. Redmond presented the Commissioners with the finished appraisal. The Commissioners thanked them for attending.
