#### Tuberculosis Control Unit

Mr. Steve Lonsinger, Coshocton County Health Department, Ms. Tammy Smith, Coshocton County Health Department, Mr. Jason Given, County Prosecutor attended the meeting to discuss the Tuberculosis Control Unit as the City of Coshocton contacted the Commissioner's Office with an active case of tuberculosis within the City of Coshocton. According to the Ohio Revised Code Section 339.72 and 339.73 it is the responsibility of the Board of County Commissioners to pay the medical expenses of this individual as the payer of last resort. Mr. Lonsinger stated that since the individual does not have insurance, this becomes the responsibility of the Board of County Commissioners. He presented an estimate of the cost of the treatment at just below \$10,000. This is over a period of 9 months. Mrs. Beck stated that she had contacted the Department of Job and Family Services and they told her that this individual will need to apply for Medicaid and see if they qualify. If they do not qualify then we could be considered the payer of last resort. Mr. Given stated that we would also need to determine what we would be required to pay if it does become our responsibility. Mr. Shryock asked if the individual will still be able to get treatment while we determine who is responsible for the payment of this bill. Mr. Lonsinger stated that anytime they have any type of outbreak they would go ahead proceed with the treatment and then get reimbursement later. Mr. Given asked if they are treating anyone else or have they just testing. Ms. Smith stated that at this time we have tested 39 other individuals that had been in contact with the patient. Mr. Lee asked if tuberculosis is curable and Ms. Smith stated that it is, but that once you have tuberculosis, you will always test positive for it. Mr. Lonsinger stated that the State of Ohio is supposed to send the Commissioners information on a grant that would help with this funding. Mr. Lonsinger stated that they will continue to work on this with the City of Coshocton and keep the Commissioners updated. The Commissioners thanked them for attending.

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Meetings Attended

Mr. Shryock and Mr. Lee attended the Three Rivers Energy Tour on August 15<sup>th</sup>. Mr. Shryock road along with Mr. Beck on his Recycling Route on August 17<sup>th</sup>.
