### Discussion - Transportation Funding

Ms. Valerie Shaw attended the meeting to discuss some of her funding for the Transportation Program. Mr. Lee stated that he understands that she is having some challenges. Ms. Shaw stated that historically DJFS has given CCCTA \$10,000. It has always gone towards the Mobility Management Grant. She stated that Mobility Management is now separate from CCCTA. At this point, she is wondering if the \$10,000 is something she can let go and just charge DJFS for the administrative work that CCCTA is doing for them. Mr. Lee asked if CCCTA is still over the Mobility Management Position. Ms. Shaw stated that they are considered a special circumstance and so that position is under her. She is thinking that she should possibly separate this grant out of her funds to make things more defined for monetary purposes. The Commissioners are in agreement with her doing this. They then discussed her rates and how this is affecting her funding. She feels they may have to change the rate structure, possibly making a flat rate for zones throughout the county. There was discussion on the need for additional drivers as well. The Commissioners stated that we will need to schedule an appointment with Mr. Danny Brenneman at DJFS to discuss some of these issues further. The Commissioners thanked them for attending.

#### Executive Session - Personnel Hiring

At 11:31 a.m. Mr. Fischer made a motion, seconded by Mr. Shryock to go into executive session with Ms. Valerie Shaw to discuss personnel hiring. All vote aye. At 12:11 p.m. the meeting was returned to regular session. No action taken.
