DJFS Monitoring

Mr. Danny Brenneman, DJFS Director attended the meeting to discuss a recent DJFS Monitoring. Mr. Brenneman stated that he has several items to discuss today. He explained the new federal rule coming down that will affect anyone that is considered abled bodied must conform with the rules and regulations in order to be eligible for food stamps. He also explained that there is a waiver that can be applied for. However, the philosophy of their agency is to comply with the rules. This affects approximately up to 300 residents. Secondly, they found out in a recent monitoring that they will no longer be able to fund a detective through the Sheriff's Office. With that being said, if this position is to continue, DJFS will need to seek local assistance with this. He stated that may have some funds available, but it does not pay for the full position. They do feel this is a very important position and he is currently seeking confirmation from the State on this. He then stated that the Child Welfare Foster costs totaled \$1,840,000 in 2019. The average costs of placement are outstanding. They have moved every piece of resources they have into this arena. They have many concerns about the holes this is leaving in our Child Support as well as Child Welfare areas. They are working with the State to rectify this situation. The Commissioners thanked him for the update.
