Teleconference - Robbie McMasters - COVID 19 Update

At 9:30 a.m. Mr. Robbie McMasters, EMA Director called in to give the Commissioners an update on the COVID 19 Pandemic. They are working with the community to help in any way possible. He praised Wylie Company and their efforts to help supply hand sanitizers. They have received a lot of PPE from the community as well. They are trying to determine the modeling for the surge and when it will hit Coshocton County. He is requesting additional funds from the Commissioners for this epidemic. He is requesting an additional \$5,000.00 if they need to purchase something additional in this response. Mr. Fischer stated that at this time we will have to take that under advisement as we are anticipating severe cuts in the general fund.

Public Hearing – 5311 & 5339 ODOT Grant Applications

At 10:00 a.m. Mr. Fischer opened the public hearing for the 5311 & 5339 ODOT Grant applications being submitted by Coshocton County Coordinated Transportation. Ms. Valerie Shaw, CCCTA Director was available via teleconference for any questions. At 10:15 a.m. Mr. Fischer closed the hearing. No persons attended

Teleconference – Mrs. Stephanie Slifko – Election Workers Pay

At 10:30 a.m. Mrs. Stephanie Slifko called and updated the Commissioners on the Election Workers Pay and how the Board of Elections intend to pay those employees. She stated that she has spoken with her association and other counties to determine what they are doing with the payroll for the election workers. They would like to pay the poll-workers for what they have already earned. They would also like to pay the poll-managers the additional \$8 for picking up the equipment as well. This will total \$2,850. Mr. Lee asked if they will need additional staff at the end of April. Mrs. Slifko stated that they hoping not to have to bring any additional staff in for that. She also stated that the Secretary of State is offering additional reimbursement for this extended election and we will receive \$10,000. This could be used for temporary staff during this time as well. She stated that the \$10,000 is just an initial amount and we will be eligible for up to \$25,000. She then reviewed some of the steps they are taking to collect the absentee ballots. The Commissioners thanked her for her call.
