Potential Contract - Sheriff's Office

Cpt. Dean Hettinger and Lt Charles Udischas attended the meeting to discuss a potential contract with the Commissioners. Lt. Udischas stated that ICS (Inmate Calling Service) are currently in contract at this time, but has presented a new contract possibility. They are now offering video visitation as an addition to the inmate phone system contract. The first \$.25 from every phone call goes to ICS, profit sharing is split then and the county will get 60.1% of the adjusted call revenue. 20 minute video visitation phone calls are \$5.00 – split \$2.50 each between ICS and the county. The unit will also have multiple other items loaded into it, including jail forms, mail, commissary, inmate handbook, etc. Lt. Udischas stated this will also help with staffing issue and alleviate some of our time factors as well, Cpt. Hettinger stated that we have not had inmate visitation since March of this year and with this contract being put in place, and they will now at least be able to see them.

Mr. Shryock made a motion, seconded by Mr. Lee to sign Amendment No. 1 to the Inmate Telephone Services Agreement with Inmate Calling Solutions, LLC to add the Visitor Video Visitation System (VVS) to the agreement.
